## Additional Performance Credit Calculations and Supplemental Information

Describe below the progress made in meeting your program year work plan inspection goals. You must provide quantitative results for each compliance inspection and land application goal listed in your work plan.

- \* In 2019 Lincoln County Focussed on getting all the feedlot registrations that are about to expire or had expired re-registered. In the spring of the year Lincoln County mails out letters notifying producers that their registration period is coming to an end and they are required to re-register. Producers then either called, stopped in the office, or site visits were performed in order to get the sites re-registered. Once the site was re-registered a reciept of registration and a copy of the registration was either mailed out to the producer or given directly to the producer in the office.
- \* In 2019 Lincoln County completed inspections on all the sites that were required to be re-registered by 2020. in 2019 Lincoln County completed 40 total inspections. In these inspections there was one site that has proposed construction. The Construction Short Form Application was submitted but the permit was issued on January 3rd, 2020 so that permit will be forwarded to the 2020 annual report for crediting. Of all 40 inspections there were 14 sites that have never recieved an inspection, 6 sites located in shoreland or DWSMA, 2 feedlot closures, and 2 land application inspections. There was 1 site found to be non-compliant do to water quality discharge standards and 2 sites that were non-compliant with N & P requirements.
- \* With all the above information it is Lincoln County's belief that we followed our current program years work plan, and inspection goals as they are listed in the 2018-2019 MPCA County Feedlot Program Delegation Agreement Work Plan.
